CASE 1:

Clean app

CASE 2:

17d. anxiety treatment, medication was given, then discontinued

CASE 3:

16e. ARTHROSCOPIC KNEE SURGERY: EIGHT YRS AGO: DUE TO SLIP AND FALL ON ICE IN NJ>

19. Daily dose of Thyroxin (0.175 micrograms)

CASE 4:

17b. Borderline - High blood pressure, Low dosage of medication to treat same

20. Same as mentioned above - Ziac 5 mg, once daily

17c. DX- diverticulitis I had a colon resection on 8/20/04.

20. Omeprazole 20mg once per day

CASE 12:

19. I have a pending claim with state of MO. Pulled and partially tore chest muscle last June at work.

CASE 13:

16e. ARTHROSCOPIC KNEE SURGERY: EIGHT YRS AGO: DUE TO SLIP AND FALL ON ICE IN NJ>

19. Daily dose of Thyroxin (0.175 micrograms)

CASE 14:

18. Strained left knee at work, workman's comp no time off -light duty from 7/04 to 1/05. full duty presently

CASE 15:

17e. BROKEN FEMUR, KNEE CAP, HIP, METAL ROB INSERTED INTO FEMUR, METAL PLATES ALSO ON RIGHT FOREARM. ALL DUE TO AUTO ACCIDENT 10/2000

CASE 16:

17g. I was diagnosed with type 2 diabetes 2 years ago. I currently take a pill a day.

CASE 17:

17a. ASTHMA, ANIMAL DANDER INDUCED, DIAGNOSED IN CHILDHOOD.

17e. DIAGNOSED WITH OSTEOARTHRITIS OF KNEE, 10 YRS. AGO. TREATMENT, NONE. ADVIL.

20. ASTHMA, INHALER. USE, ONCE OR TWICE YEARLY.

CASE 18:

17f. Prostate Cancer, Had a Prostatectomy and was cleared of an cancer remaining and no further treatments necessary.

20. Axert and Imitrex for Migraine Headaches

CASE 19:

17b. High blood pressure Exercise - Stress reduction

17c. Crohns Disease Remission

20. 1000mg Sulfasalazine x3 day 50mg Tenormin x1 day

CASE 20:

17d. Depression. Prescriptions.

20. Depakote 500mg once a day. Paxil 37.5mg once per day. Wellbutrin 300mg once per day. Trazodone 150mg once per day

CASE 21:

18. Post-Partum Depression (2000)

19. After my initial treatment for Post-Partum Depression, both of my children were later diagnosed with Autism/PDD. My primary physician recommended that I remain on a low "maintenance" dose of Effexor XR to help deal with the stress and other issues involved in caring for 2 disabled children.
